KURT DOELLING'S AMAZON KAYAKING ADVENTURE

Kurt Doelling, a Vice President at Oracle in Redwood City, is a Lincoln Hills homeowner, and has done several hikes with our club. Last year he participated in a 10 day kayaking adventure trip into the Amazon jungles of Ecuador.

With an outfit which provided both naturalists and aboriginal guides, he and his small group paddled the river systems around the Yasuni National Park in kayaks.

This region of Ecuador holds the highest concentration of flora and fauna species in the world and is home to two indigenous tribes who until very recently were still living in isolation.

The silent paddling made for outstanding wildlife viewing and encounters. This will be a treat for bird watchers, outdoor enthusiasts and nature lovers alike.
